



# *Rosary Makers*

The Rosary Makers group was started in December 2002 for the purpose of making military rosaries for the soldiers in the war in Iraq as well as for the missions and the sick. This ministry has been nationally recognized by President Bush during his National Day of Prayer speech on May 1, 2003. As of December 2012, 102,000 rosaries have been made and the group supplies all the surrounding hospitals with rosaries.

This ministry is funded by private donations. Children are welcome to join in this special ministry.
